

Dear Parents and Guardians,
Summer shouldn't mean taking a break from learning, especially reading. Studies suggest that most students experience a loss of reading skills over the summer months, but children who continue to read during the summer months will gain skills. So, let's read!

Efforts should be made during the summer to help children sustain reading skills, practice reading and read for enjoyment. Here are a few family tips to make reading enjoyable for your children this summer:


## 1. Read aloud together with your child every day. Make it fun by

 reading outdoors on the front steps, patio, at the beach or park. Also, let your children read to you. For younger children, point out the relationship between words and sounds.2. Set a good example. Parents need to model reading for their children. Keep lots of reading material around the house. Turn off the TV and have each person read his or her book, including mom and dad.
3. Read the same book your child is reading and discuss it. This is the way to develop habits of the mind and build capacity for thought and insight.
4. Let kids choose what they want to read. Not allowing choice may discourage good reading habits.
5. Buy audio books, especially for a child with a learning disability. Listen to them in the car, or turn off the TV and have the family listen to them together.
6. Take your children to the public library regularly. The Cesar Chavez Library sponsors summer reading programs with easy-to-reach goals for school-age children. Check the library calendar for special summer reading activities and events. They also provide age-appropriate book lists for summer reading.
7. Make family trips a way to encourage reading by reading aloud traffic signs, billboards, notices. Show your children how to read a map, and once you are on the road, let them take turns being the navigator.
8. Encourage children to keep a summer scrapbook. Tape in souvenirs of your family's summer activities picture postcards, ticket stubs, photos. Have your children write the captions and read them and read them aloud as you look at the book together.

## Promotion Ceremony Tickets

Parents must pick-up promotion tickets in the Main Office beginning Monday, May 8. Each family has been allotted five (5) tickets. If a family needs more tickets, that can be discussed when they pick them up. Tickets must be presented when guests enter the gates on Tuesday, May 23.

8th Grade Trip on Friday, May 19
8th grade students will go on a class trip to Harkins Theater to see The Super Mario Bros. Movie.
