Dear Families,

Most children today are tech savvy. Children, however, need their parents to provide guidelines to help ensure that they use technology safely and responsibly. Here are some tips for helping your child enjoy the benefits of technology, while minimizing the risks:

1. **Spend time with your child online.** Navigate websites, perform searches, and bookmark web pages. If your child is good at using the internet, let your child do the navigating.
2. **Have your child show you a favorite app or website.** Ask your child why they like it. This is a good way to keep the lines of communication open, and to see where your child is going online.
3. **Monitor your child's online gaming.** Some games on the internet contain explicit violence, mature language, and sexual content. Many games also feature chat rooms where children may be exposed to predators or adult content.

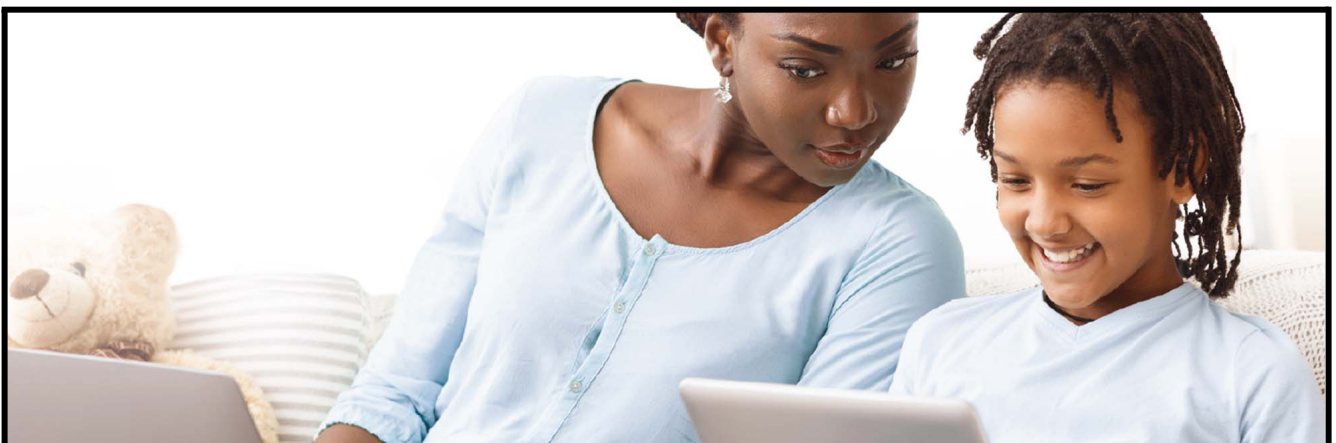
Discuss the benefits and dangers of the internet, and make sure your child knows that people online may not be who they say they are. Remind your child to never give out personal information, such as name, address, phone number, or school.

SOCIAL MEDIA SPOTLIGHT: SNAPCHAT

Most popular for its fun photo filters, Snapchat is a favorite platform of young people. **Features:** Users can post photo “stories,” which are pictures and videos that disappear after 24 hours. Private chat messages and “snaps” (photos and videos) sent between individual or groups of users also disappear after an allotted time, although users do have the option to save them. Users can “screenshot” conversations and save them permanently to their phone, however, the other user is notified. **What to look out for:** Users’ locations can also be shared as well on a feature called Snap Map. This feature is able to be turned off and on.
